DEGREES OF HEARING LOSS

Hearing loss is graded according to decibel loss in either ear.
For convenience, five categories of hearing loss are recognised:

Mild	06-40 dB
Moderate	41-55 dB
Moderate-Severe	56-70 dB
Severe	71-90 dB
Profound	91- dB

For Deaf or Hearing Impaired rugby players, hearing loss is defined as average hearing loss of at least **25 dB** in both ears (ASHA 1981, NIOSH 1998 standard as average frequency of 1000, 2000, 3000 & 4000 Hertz).

Note: hearing aids or cochlear implant cannot be worn during a hearing test.

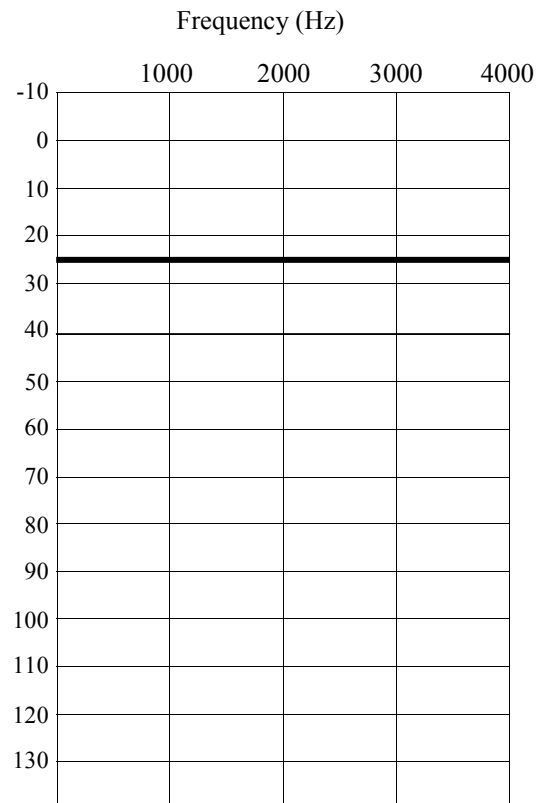
